

## SAFETY TIPS

1. Never drink and drive a snowmobile
2. Drive within the limits of the machine, the trail you are on, and most important—your abilities as an operator. Putting on the gas rarely gets one out of a dangerous situation.
3. Obey the trail riding rules as well as the laws of the state and speed limit.
4. Be extra careful when crossing roads and pay extra care to cross at a right angle to traffic.
5. Keep your machine in top condition. Be sure to do a "pre-trail check" before riding. A broken down snowmobile on the trail is an opportunity for an accident.
6. Be sure to wear appropriate, dry clothing. These items include: gloves, boots and a helmet with a visor. "When the U.P. weather turns bad quickly one cannot put on clothing not taken along."
7. Treat the outdoors with respect. Do not litter, damage trees or other vegetation.
8. Make family or friends aware of your planned route, destination and arrival time in case of any difficulties along the way.
9. Take extra care to respect the property rights of others. Vast amounts of time are needed to gain permissions needed for the trails. It is a shame when a visitor, or even worse, a local rider does not take care and ruins it for all.
10. If you see trouble along the trail, be sure to stop and lend a hand. It is one of the things that makes the U.P. great!
11. If you see damage or trouble along the trail caused by people not obeying rules, contact the DNR.
12. Be sure to obey signs and show extra care around groomers, plow trucks, logging trucks and logging equipment. All machines can be very dangerous in their own right and operators are often concentrating on their work
